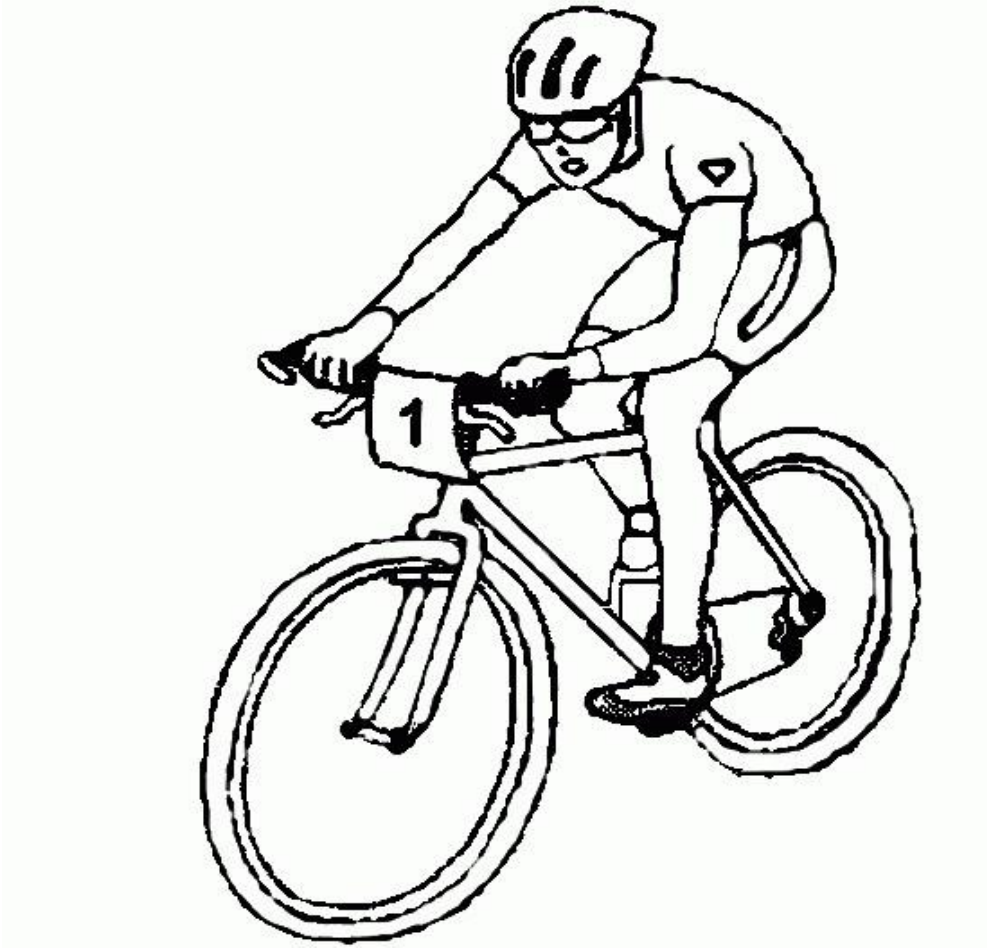


The lesson for young learners using bike.

The aim: Review the colours and the parts of bike

The materials: Printed pictures, colouring pencils

1. Review the colours. ( touch something blue, red... etc.)
2. Teacher ask some questions about riding bikes and suitable clothes.
3. Teacher put the picture of the bike on the board and pupils come one by one and show and name bicycle parts.
4. Teacher gives the worksheet to every pupil and they read and colour.
  1. Colour the helmet blue.
  2. Colour the sunglasses yellow.
  3. Colour the Tshirt red.
  4. Colour the shorts black. 5. Colour the frame green.
  6. Colour the tyres brown.
  7. Colour the number purple.



**READ AND COLOUR**

Colour the tyres BLACK.

Colour the saddle RED.

Colour the frame BLUE.

Colour the chain ring PINK.

Colour the handles BROWN.
