

Subject: Bike rules - modal verbs of obligation.

AGE: 12-15 years.

OBJECTIVES:

1. Students know the difference between the verbs: MUST, HAVE TO, MUSTN'T, DON'T HAVE TO
2. Students can create their own rules.

STAGES:

- I. Students do a test containing four questions with must, mustn't, have to, don't have to.
- II.
 1. Teacher explains the difference between the modal verbs from the test.
 2. Students fill in the rest of the test with the correct verbs
 3. Students check their answers with the teacher.
 4. WORK IN GROUPS: Students create their funny rules about travelling by bike and illustrate them.

Example tasks:

- Imagine you live in the past.
- Imagine you live in 2100 year.
- Imagine you live on a different planet.
