

## **The lesson for young learners using bike.**

The aim: To use the map and review the directions and prepositions of place.

The materials: printed paper of the map and task.

1. Review the directions, play the game- Simple Simon says- turn left, turn right, asks who sits next to you, behind you e.t.c.
2. Give the printed paper to children and get introduce with the map by asking questions: How many streets are there? Name them. Find the place where you are!...
3. Children read the description and write down the places. Then read loudly and check.
4. Then children write the way to the cinema.
5. Then children write the way to other place and read at first to deskmate then to others at class .
